

The objective of this seminar was to develop the students spiritually and build self-confidence, enhance self-esteem and improve overall personality. The programme aimed at grooming the students through sensitizing them about proper behavior, socially and professionally in both formal and informal circumstances. Prof. Praveen raj saxena were the resource persons on this special event.

Addressing the gathering Prof. Praveen raj saxena spoke on life skills. Life skills are abilities for adaptive and positive behavior that enables humans to deal effectively with the demands and challenges of life.



Seminar Program on Empowering Engineering Students through Employability Skills

A professional course program like engineering strives to get the maximum number of its students placed through campus interviews. While communication skills have been added in all the engineering courses with the aim to improve their performance in placement, the syllabus mostly concentrates on the development of four language skills. The students are not made aware of the employability skills and their significance. This essay intends to enlist the importance of skills and why students need to be aware of the skills they possess and how they can work on packaging their candidature around a few skills. The discussion starts by addressing the apparent gap between academic programs for engineering students and industry skills requirements. A list of vital employability skills from the standpoint of engineering students follows, with a discussion on how to potentially develop such skills through campus life. The essay stresses the role of academia in filling this gap by acting as facilitators in a three-step process (i.e., awareness, self-analysis, and acquisition). The author concludes that the combination of both employability skills along with an engineering degree should ensure students meet the high expectations of the employers. Presiding over the function, Ch Gopal Reddy garu, Secretary & Correspondent, CMRGI.exhorted the students to make use of the training offered by the College to prepare themselves to get employment in Corporates.

He is expected to show decent corporate etiquette at the time of interview itself, and hence training becomes very vital for graduates.

In an era of rapid change and fierce competition, their efforts to learn new things and acquire certain skills will not only make them confident and self-assured, but will also give them an advantage in the job interview. Employers clearly look forward to candidates who are focused and are passionate about the profession they aspire to enter; therefore, making an effort to hone their attributes can definitely improve their job prospects. Thus, the onus now is on academia to understand the needs of the industry and students by creating awareness and guiding the students in self-analysis and in acquisition of skills.

Report on Road Safety Awareness

A Lecture on "Road Safety for Divyangs" held at CMRCET, Hyderabad on 03rd December, 2019 by shyam sunder reddy traffic police who gave informative lecture to the students.

He informed the students that owning to the violation of traffic rules on roads by the underaged driving roads has become very unsafe, especially persons.



The students enthusiastically participated in interactive session with shyam sunder reddy traffic police and were inspired with his words, participants recognized about how critical road safety is. The participants took responsibility of ensuring that their family members follow the rules for road safety, as breaking the rules might be dangerous or fatal.

Principal Major. Dr. V. A. Narayana and Dr. M. Vishnu flagged off the safety walk at college campus area and spread awareness by holding placards with messages of safety on the roads while driving and walking, shouted slogans. The policemen who were on traffic duty, assisted in the smooth movement of traffic and safety of the students. In the seminar, all the students explained about importance of wearing helmets to the participants.



Outcomes

- 1. It recognizes that prevention efforts notwithstanding, road users will remain fallible and crashes will occur.
- 2. It stresses that those involved in the design of the road transport system need to accept and share responsibility for the safety of the system, and those that use the system need to accept responsibility for complying with the rules and constraints of the system.
